

Cache County 2024 General Election: By the Numbers

Registered Voters: In the time between the Primary and General elections, voter rolls grew by over **6,000**, reaching a total of **74,356** registered voters by the close of the election!

Precincts and Ballots:

Ballots were created for **167** precincts, requiring **31** unique ballot styles crafted around **40** races with **69** candidates and **11** write-ins!

Turnout Highlights:

Of the **72,011** ballots sent to voters across the County, **62,148** were returned and counted giving Cache County an **86.3%** turnout rate!

Mail & Drop Box Voting: 55,629 voters dropped their ballot in their mailbox or one of our 21 ballot dropboxes across the county.

In-Person Voting: We saw a total of **7,191** voters show up to cast their vote or drop off their ballot at Early & Election Day polling centers.

Provisional Voting: **2,231** same-day provisional voters were processed on November 5th, ensuring everyone had the chance to participate.

Military & Overseas Citizens: 258 ballots were cast electronically through the FPCA program.

Signature Cures: Our team tackled **1,027** ballots with signature issues, contacting voters by mail, email, or phone to help them "cure" their ballots.

Votes Counted: We reviewed an incredible **2.48 million** ovals across all ballots—talk about dedication to accuracy!

Speaking of Accuracy: We aced the LGO's post-election hand-count audit, with a score of **100%!**

Election Staff & Support:

3 full-time and 4 part-time staff, 46 seasonal employees and 20 volunteers in collaboration with 19 municipal agencies and law enforcement worked tirelessly to ensure a smooth, safe, and accurate election process. A huge thank-you to our hardworking team, volunteers, and community partners who made this election a success!
