Application Deadline: Completed application forms must be submitted to the Cache County Development Services Office forty-five (45) calendar days before an event is scheduled to take place. This allows sufficient time for evaluation of the application. Late applications shall be denied unless the applicant demonstrates that compliance with the 45 day deadline was impractical or impossible due to the nature of the event. A special event permit application may be approved and a permit issued to the applicant by the Director upon approval by all the agencies specified in Section 8.40.40.

**Authority:** Cache County has no authority to approve permits for events other than in the unincorporated area of Cache County. Permits issued by Cache County apply only to the unincorporated area of the county, and if an event crosses into a municipality within Cache County or across the county line, applicants should determine if a permit is necessary in the other jurisdiction.

**Right to Deny:** Cache County reserves the right to deny permit applications for proposed special events which may pose, or have posed a significant danger or threat to the public health, welfare or safety, or which may result in unreasonable inconvenience or cost to the public. In the event the application is denied, the applicant may appeal to the Cache County Executive.

#### APPLICATION CHECKLIST

A complete application must include the following unless specified otherwise:

### PROJECT REVIEW PROCESS

- The applicant is encouraged to meet with staff prior to the deadline date to discuss the project and ensure that the information submitted is sufficient to provide a complete review of the project.
- After the application is accepted, information packets are sent to various departments, agencies, and affected municipalities that provide comments and/or approval for the proposed event to the Director of Development Services.
- In some instances a pre-event meeting may be held with planning staff and representatives from the departments and agencies that provide comments on the project review. Any issues present on a project will be discussed with the appropriate department or agency.
- A draft permit is made available to the reviewing agencies, affected municipalities, staff, and the applicant.
- Following agency/department review and approval, and correction of any outstanding concerns/issues, the permit can be issued.

Logan Rotary Club is proud to sponsor The Logan Rotary RAW.

In its fourth year, RAW is a recreational bicycle event starts and ends in Logan while riding around the base of the steepest mountains in North America... the Wellsville Mountains. This year's event features three rides, 66-mile ride and a 96-mile ride that extends RAW in Box Elder county and a 23-mile (to the base of the Wellsville Mountains) family ride in Cache Valley.

RAW will begin and end in at the Rotary Pavilion at Willow Park West, 500 West 700 South, Logan Utah. All money earned will assist the Rotary Club of Logan to increase literacy here and abroad, to reduce hunger, and to fight life-threatening diseases around the planet by providing clean water.

The majority of this year's proceeds will go towards providing clean water in a community abroad.

Who: All Bike Riders

What:

• 23-mile Family RAW, a leisurely ride across the beautiful Cache Valley to Wellsville, returning to the Rotary Pavilion at Willow Park via the same route.

• 66-mile RAW Classic non-competitive supported bike ride around the Wellsville mountain range.

• 96-mile Tour de RAW non-competitive supported bike ride around the Wellsville mountain range extending the additional mileage into Box Elder County and the Bear River Bird Refuge.

**Expected Number of Participants: about 200** 

#### Public Health Plans:

- Culinary water for participants: Water from known sources (homes) will be available at the ride start and at the rest stops. Riders will fill their water bottles from those water coolers.
- All solid waste collected at the starting place and rest stops will be put in plastic bags and disposed of properly.
- Where there are no established public sanitary facilities at the rest stops there will be portable sanitary facilities with hand washing stations provided.

Insurance: The Rotary International insurance policy covers this event for liability. Each political entity will be named as an additional insured for this event only. That policy is renewed annually on July 1. Thus, a current certificate of insurance in the form of the attached will be provided after July 1, 2014 and before the event on July 26, 2014.

Fire Prevention and Emergency Medical Services: It is not believed that fire is one of the threats generated by this event. If there is a medical emergency the standard practice of calling 911 will be used if the person is in any danger. There will be a "sag-wagon" with first aid equipment that will respond to any not-so-serious problems.


Security plans and/or law enforcement response: The event will take place on public property including highways. Should there be a need for support from law enforcement the event organizers will contact the appropriate law enforcement body. All law enforcement agencies having jurisdiction over any part of the course will be notified of the event well ahead of time and reminded in the days immediately preceding the event.

Admission: A nominal fee is paid by each participant to cover the costs of the event.

Parking: There is ample parking in Willow Park at the beginning and ending of the event. Since the event is over by about 3:00 pm there is little competition for the parking in Willow Park other than that required for the farmers market. Past experience has shown that there is no conflict in this regards.
