**Application Deadline:** Completed application forms must be submitted to the Cache County Development Services Office forty-five (45) calendar days before an event is scheduled to take place. This allows sufficient time for evaluation of the application. Late applications shall be denied unless the applicant demonstrates that compliance with the 45 day deadline was impractical or impossible due to the nature of the event. A special event permit application may be approved and a permit issued to the applicant by the Director upon approval by all the agencies specified in Section 8.40.40.

**Authority:** Cache County has no authority to approve permits for events other than in the unincorporated area of Cache County. Permits issued by Cache County apply only to the unincorporated area of the county, and if an event crosses into a municipality within Cache County or across the county line, applicants should determine if a permit is necessary in the other jurisdiction.

**Right to Deny:** Cache County reserves the right to deny permit applications for proposed special events which may pose, or have posed a significant danger or threat to the public health, welfare or safety, or which may result in unreasonable inconvenience or cost to the public. In the event the application is denied, the applicant may appeal to the Cache County Executive.

## **Clarkston Martin Harris Pageant**

### **Security Plan and Law Enforcement**

We provide 24-hour, 7 day a week security from August 4 through August 12 with 120 security volunteers from 12 LDS stakes within the Cache region of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latterday Saints. We have 2 security personnel on site continuously during this time period. Each 2-man security team serves for 4 hours to ensure that the set, light and sound equipment and grounds are protected. We ask them to be courteous, helpful and non-confrontational should any situation need their attention and we advise them to notify law enforcement personnel if needed. In addition, we have arranged with the Cache County Sheriff's office to provide one officer to be on site each evening of the performance from 7:30 to about 11 p.m. in case any need arises for emergency or law enforcement assistance. We also have 8 volunteers each evening of the performance who assist with traffic and parking at the site. We have a number of traffic signs that we install to slow and direct traffic and assist in entering and exiting the event.

### Fire Prevention and Emergency Medical Service

We have arranged with the Newton Fire Department and EMT personnel to be on site every evening of the performance with an emergency support vehicle. We maintain the driveway through the cemetery as a "no parking" fire lane and also keep all other drive lanes and streets open by restricting parking to designated areas. We maintain fire extinguishers in the storage shed and in the mobile restroom facility that is brought on site by the church. We mow, trim and edge the grass around the amphitheater along and around the storage shed to minimize combustible vegetation and maintain a firebreak as much as possible.

### **Pageant Information**

The pageant runs from August 4 through August 12, excepting Sundays and Mondays. It is an open air theatrical production with benched seating in the amphitheater located on the south side of the Clarkston, Utah cemetery. It begins at 8:30 p.m. each evening and runs about 90 minutes. Admission is free, but tickets are required. The cost of the production is borne by the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The production is presented by a volunteer cast of over 100 people. In addition, several hundred volunteers help erect the set and assist with ushering, parking, security, and other production needs. 

### PROJECT REVIEW PROCESS

- The applicant is encouraged to meet with staff prior to the deadline date to discuss the project and ensure that the information submitted is sufficient to provide a complete review of the project.
- After the application is accepted, information packets are sent to various departments, agencies, and affected municipalities that provide comments and/or approval for the proposed event to the Director of Development Services.
- In some instances a pre-event meeting may be held with planning staff and representatives from the departments and agencies that provide comments on the project review. Any issues present on a project will be discussed with the appropriate department or agency.
- A draft permit is made available to the reviewing agencies, affected municipalities, staff, and the applicant.
- Following agency/department review and approval, and correction of any outstanding concerns/issues, the permit can be issued.


