The Fire District has reviewed the Special Event permit request for the Bike MS bike ride. In general, this event will have minimal impact on fire and EMS resources. Past events such as this have occasionally required a medical response to a bike accident.

Of special concern is the violation of traffic laws such as groups of cyclists riding more than two abreast and failure to yield to emergency vehicles. The applicant indicates they will remind riders to ride no more than two abreast. We would suggest that this is strictly followed.

Hi Laurie,

As a result of last year's misfortune I believe I visited with you, or someone in your office, and Alexis Johnson about my concerns with holding this event and having it routed through Clarkston on the same day as our Pony Express celebration. You will recall four cyclists were hit and two were seriously injured as the result of the congestion this race and our event caused. The horse race, that is part of our celebration, attracts riders from all over the state and Southern Idaho and we have been holding this event the same weekend long before this ride/race was organized. In my conversations with the organizers last year I provided the exact date of when this year's celebration would be and unfortunately it appears the organizers have chosen to disregard my recommendations and concerns. Putting that many cyclists and the traffic, our celebration creates, could ultimately lead to further problems and my biggest concern is a something even worse than last year and that is a death of a cyclist; so I strongly object to this ride coming into Clarkston. As I suggested last year they could alter the route and go through Newton Dam to get on the road going back to Trenton. I sincerely hope that someone will seriously consider this situation and the ramifications of going forward as planned. Please feel free to contact me if we need to discuss further.

Application Deadline: Completed application forms must be submitted to the Cache County Development Services Office forty-five (45) calendar days before an event is scheduled to take place. This allows sufficient time for evaluation of the application. Late applications shall be denied unless the applicant demonstrates that compliance with the 45 day deadline was impractical or impossible due to the nature of the event. A special event permit application may be approved and a permit issued to the applicant by the Director upon approval by all the agencies specified in Section 8.40.40.

Authority: Cache County has no authority to approve permits for events other than in the unincorporated area of Cache County. Permits issued by Cache County apply only to the unincorporated area of the county, and if an event crosses into a municipality within Cache County or across the county line, applicants should determine if a permit is necessary in the other jurisdiction.

Right to Deny: Cache County reserves the right to deny permit applications for proposed special events which may pose, or have posed a significant danger or threat to the public health, welfare or safety, or which may result in unreasonable inconvenience or cost to the public. In the event the application is denied, the applicant may appeal to the Cache County Executive.







A. Rest Stop 1 (Benson)


