
- 5. **Health:** A first aid station will be available at all times by someone who is CPR Certified.





Aubrey,

I have reached out to Pernilla with some questions and recommendations for the Health Department. Their water sample results are almost 2 years old. Where contamination can be entered into a private water system at anytime, we are recommending that they have their water sampled again before the event to ensure the water source is still clean. Also, all food service booths - whether food is to be given away or sold - require a temporary food service permit from us. They list the event as a private event; however, anyone can buy a ticket online through eventbrite.com - which makes it a public event in the eyes of food safety (it's not by invitation only for the guests expected to attend).

Other than that, nothing else is required from the health department.

1. People will be standing inside the warehouse but I will have a few benches on the sides of the walls where a handful of people could sit down if they need to. I will have some chairs in the outside access area as well.

2. The stage I am renting is from a stage company where its portable so they take it apart to transport it there and then they put it back together. Not sure if that is prefabricated or considered built. It's just made out of metal trusses that look like a big stand made out of metal with some lighting attached.



This is the stage but the only thing they are bringing is the pink lights, the metal bar structure connected directly to the lights and the speakers. There will be nothing else included that is in the picture (also does not include the bar cage surrounding the speakers) They might bring that small platform in the middle bottom of the picture but it is prefabricated I'm assuming.
