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Compliance Corner 10-9a-306 Utah State Code

Each issue of Cache Planning News will have a "Compliance Corner" section. To update you on a common compliance issue that affects many codes throughout the County and the State. This month's issue: Title10 Chapter 9a Section 306 of the Utah Code which states:

"(1) A Land Use Authority shall apply the Plain language of land use regulations (2) If a land use regulation does not plainly restrict a land use application, the land use authority shall interpret and apply the land use regulation to favor the land use application (3) A land use decision of a land use authority is an administrative act, even if the land use authority is the legislative body"

The courts have essentially ruled this provision is saying "Anything you don't specifically prohibit must be allowed." This can be problematic as most of our zoning codes are written to say what is allowed in a zoning district, not what isn't allowed.

Luckily there is an easy fix. Adding a statement at the beginning of each zoning chapter stating "Any use not specifically permitted in this chapter shall be prohibited" While this will place you in compliance just remember, if a proposed land use isn't specifically allowed you should deny it
