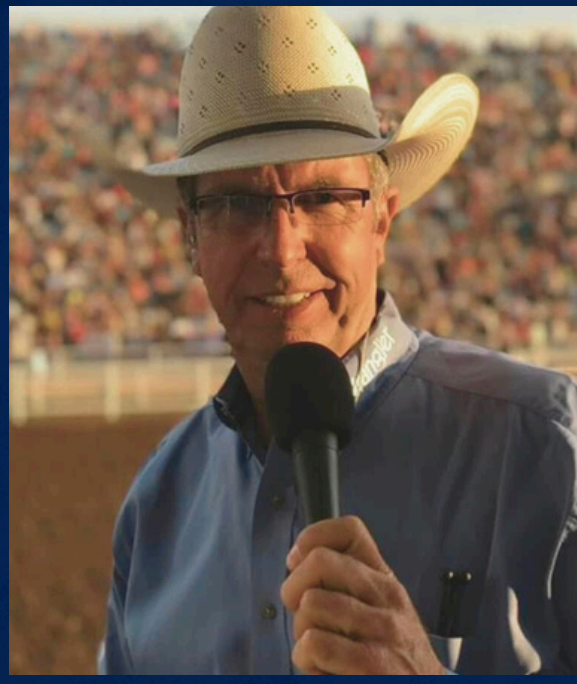

When he first started moving hay with a team and sickle bar mower, his feet barely reached the footrest, he remembers his dad hanging a bucket of rocks under the seat to balance the tongue and take weight off the horse's necks because he was so small.

Seeing multiple horses work together and work on voice commands is something that never grew old to him. Developing horses that know your voice and listen is very rewarding.

The older style Percheron Draft Horse has been Parkers breed of choice and he has spent the last decade breeding and raising his own horses.

Driving horses has brought wonderful opportunities to participate in many events from the Minnesota Circus Parade in Wisconsin to parades and rodeos across the western states driving the Wells Fargo Stagecoach to driving 20 horses and 6 original ore wagons in Ketchum Wagon Days with his dad and brothers. Along the way there have been many wonderful people and experiences. What he enjoys most is hooking a team of horses up with his kids and feeding cows at home.

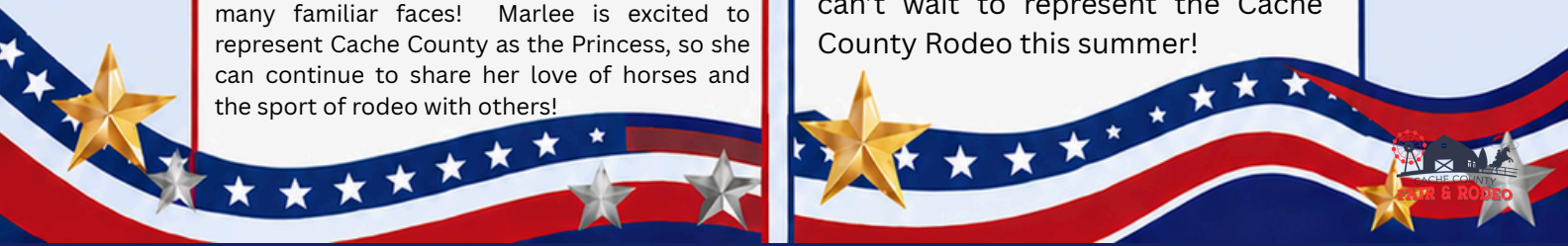
Marlee Hall
