

SUPERVISORS REPORT

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Cache County, Utah:

Comes now the Board of Supervisors of the Cache County Drainage District Number Three and hereby makes and files with the Board of County Commissioners of Cache County, Utah, its findings and report, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 2053 and 2054, Chapter 41, Session Laws of Utah, 1919, as amended by Chapter 47 of the Session Laws of Utah, 1921:

1. That immediately after their appointment, the Board of Supervisors of the Cache County Drainage District Number Three employed as engineers of the said district, Humphreys Brothers of Logan, Utah, with Hays, Sloan and Lewis of Boise, Idaho, as associate engineers, and that this Board of Supervisors with the said engineers having examined all of the said lands proposed to be drained or protected and the lands over or upon which the work is proposed to be constructed; that the said engineers have made a complete survey and map of the lands within the said district as well as exhaustive investigation of sub-surface conditions both with reference to the soil and to the ground water; that the said engineers have made a detailed written report to the Board of Supervisors of the results of their survey and investigation and a copy of the said report is submitted to the County Commissioners with this report for their reference and further information.

That from the said examination by the supervisors and report of the said engineers this Board now makes the following findings and report:





(a) "Whether the proposed work and the proposed location thereof are in all respects proper and feasible; and if not, what is or are so."

The drainage system proposed in the petition for the organization of the district is feasible and proper, except for the changes hereinafter mentioned. The engineers who have had the preliminary work in charge are of the opinion that the boundaries of the district should be enlarged so as to include the additional lands shown on the map attached hereto and made a part of this report. The supervisors are of the opinion however that it will be impossible to enlarge the boundaries of the said district on account of the opposition of the land owners owning the lands without the boundaries of the district as created and within the lines of the boundaries as proposed by the engineers. Some of the drains on account of flat slopes, quicksand and large discharge, necessarily should be open ditches and concrete tile may properly be substituted for clay tile under certain conditions. That a proper description of the feasible drainage system for the said land is as follows:

The primary system consists of the following drains: <u>No. 1.</u> An open ditch having its outlet in a natural water course near the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 19, Township 14 North of Range 1 East of the Salt Lake Base and Meridian and running thence west approximately one quarter mile; thence north approximately one and three quarter miles; thence westerly approximately one quarter mile; thence northeasterly along the east side of the right of way of the Utah-Idaho Central railroad to the north side of the county road between Sections 12 and 13, Township 14 North of Range 1 West; thence east approximately one and three quarter miles.

<u>No. 2.</u> An open ditch having its outlet in drain No. 1, near the west quarter corner of Section 18, Township 14 North of Range 1 East and running thence in a southeasterly direction approximately one mile.

No. 3. An open ditch having its outlet in a natural water course



near the southeast corner of Section 20, Township 14 North of Range 1 East and running thence in a northerly direction approximately two miles.

<u>No. 4.</u> An open ditch having its outlet in drain No. 3, in the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 21, Township 14 North of Range 1 East and running thence in a northwesterly direction across Sections 20 and 19 approximately 7200 feet. <u>No. 5.</u> An open ditch having its outlet at the culvert under the Utah-Idaho Central railroad track in the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 25, Township 14 North of Range 1 West and running thence in a northeasterly and northerly direction to a point near the center of Section 24, Township 14 North of Range 1 West.

<u>No. 6.</u> A closed drain having its outlet in drain No. 3 near the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 21, Township 14 North of Range 1 East and running thence in an easterly direction approximately 500 feet. <u>No. 7.</u> A closed drain having its outlet in drain No. 1, near the southwest corner of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 13, Township 14 North of Range 1 West and running thence in a northwesterly direction approximately 1900 feet. <u>No. 8.</u> A closed drain having its outlet in drain No. 5 in the north-

west quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 24, Township 14 North of Range 1 West and running thence in a northeasterly direction approximately 2200 feet.

(b) "The probable cost of the work mentioned in the petition, including all incidental expenses, and the cost of the proceedings therefor;"

The probable aggregate cost of the proposed work as set forth herein including all incidental expenses and cost of organization will be \$175,000.00.



(c) "The probable annual cost of keeping the same in repair after the work is completed;"

The probable annual cost of keeping the drainage system in repair will be \$750.00.

(d) "What lands will be injured by the proposed work, and the probable aggregate amount of all damages such land will sustain by reason of the laying out and construction of such work; and what lands, if any, should be excluded from the district;"

The lands damaged by the construction of the proposed system will be a strip one hundred feet wide taken for right of way for the open ditches. The aggregate amount of such damages will be approximately \$19,200.00. There will be no damage caused by the construction of the closed drains as they are all on land which is practically non-productive at the present time.

The Board of Supervisors reports that the following tract of land included within the boundaries of the district, viz:

The west half of the northwest quarter of Section 13, Township 14 North of Range 1 West, will not be affected by the construction of the proposed system of drains and should be excluded from the district.

> (e) "what lands will be benefitted by the construction of the proposed work, and whether the aggregate amount of benefits will equal or exceed the cost of constructing such work, including all incidental expenses, cost of proceedings, and damages;"

All the lands in the district with the exception noted in (d) above will be benefitted by the construction of the proposed works. The aggregate amount of benefits which will accrue from the construction of the drainage system is \$510,000.00, in the event of the inclusion within the boundaries of said district of the lands adjoining and shown upon the map of the engineers hereunto attached to this report, and which in the opinion of said engineers will be equally benefitted by the construction of the said drainage system as provided, and that the aggregate amount of benefits which will accrue from the construction of the drainage system to the lands lying without the boundaries of the said district as established by the proclamation of the Board of County Commissioners on the 27th day of June, 1921, will be reduced from \$510,000.00 to approximately \$290,000.00. The benefits will exceed the cost of constructing such work, including all incidental expenses, cost of proceedings and damages, in either event.

> (f) "Whether the proposed district as set out in the petition filed will enbrace all the lands that may be damaged or benefitted by the proposed work; and if not, to report what additional lands will be so affected."

The district as proposed will not enbrace all the lands


which will be benefitted by the construction of the drainage system. In the opinion of the engineers, who have conducted the preliminary investigations, other lands outside the boundaries of the district as created by the proclamation of the Board ofCounty Commissioners on the 27th day of June, 1921, and as shown in the map attached hereto and made a part of this report and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, will be equally benefitted by the construction of the said Drainage System as proposed, but that the Board of Supervisors on account of the opposition of the land owners in the area benefitted outside of the boundaries of the district as already established have concluded not to ask for the inclusion of such benefitted lands with the lands within the boundaries of the district as already established.

The Board of Supervisors further reports that the aggregate amount of benefits which will accrue from the construction of the drainage system within the boundaries of the district as already established will be at least \$100.00 per acre or approximately \$290,000.00. The benefits will exceed the cost of construction including all incidental expenses, costs of the proceedings and damages. To this report of the Board of Supervisors is attached the engineers' report on said Drainage District Number Three, which is also made a part of said report and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars thereof.

And the Board of Supervisors having found that the benefits derived from the said drainage system will exceed the costs and expenses of the construction and maintenance and damages and respectfully requests that this report be accepted by the Board of County Commissioners in the manner and form prescribed by law.

Bishop Watkins, representing Maria Anderson protests that she is assessed with 115 acres while she has only about 15 acres that needs draining.

WM E. Rigby nomated H. C. Pitcher to be recommended to the Co Commissioners for 3 year term superviser. Mr. Pitcher resigned and nomated M. Brackmannas 3 year term.

Motion was duly seconded. Motion was duly put by J. W. Boman and unamiously carried. Wm E. Rigby nomiated Hazen M. Spackman to be recommended as 2 year term supervisor
