Request for Civilian Rider in County Vehicles

Requirements for Civilian Riders in County Vehicles

- Persons intending to ride as part of an organization, group, or class shall contact the Patrol Sergeant at least one day before the time the rider wishes to accompany a Sheriff's Deputy.
- The rider understands that riding with the deputy is a privilege and not a right, and that if the deputy deems it necessary, he/she may ask the rider to leave the vehicle and retreat to a safe place.
- The rider understands that he/she is a citizen observer with no police authority and agrees to act as directed by the deputy in all situations. The rider shall not wear any insignia or uniform that suggests that he/she is a law enforcement officer if he/she is not.
- The rider will keep confidential all information obtained while participating in this program, unless otherwise directed by the Sheriff's Office. Any breach of this trust will permanently bar the participant from riding with deputies.
- The rider agrees to dress and grooming which is in accordance with the Sheriff's Office dress code:
...shall keep their persons clean and sanitary by frequently bathing, proper barbering, and clean presentable clothing...clean, pressed...conservative dress should be emphasized; ragged or worn blue denim levis, t-shirts, hats, shorts, cutoffs, flip-flops, sandals, and Levi jackets are not allowed.
- Riders agree to provide their own transportation to and from the Sheriff's Office.
- The Rider understands that participating in this program is subject to review and may be terminated by the Patrol Sergeant if in his opinion the rider's presence detracts from or encumbers the mission of the Sheriff's Office.
- Riders agree to wear seat-belts when the vehicle is moving if they are available.
- Riders understand that they are only allowed to leave the vehicle when approved by the Deputy.
- Riders are not allowed to possess weapons during the ride along. Exceptions for law enforcement and concealed weapon permit holders must be approved by the Sergeant.
