

Victim/Witness Information

Reporting

If you are the victim or witness of a crime that has not been reported, please contact the dispatch center. If it is an emergency, please dial 9-1-1. For non-emergency situations, please dial 716-9400. If you have already been contacted by a representative of law enforcement and you have further questions, you may contact the representative directly. If you did not receive or no longer have the representative's contact information you may either contact his/her agency directly or contact dispatch.

Jurisdiction

The agency with jurisdiction is determined by the location of the incident. When you contact the dispatch center, a representative of the appropriate agency will be assigned to contact you.

- Provide extra patrols in the vicinity of the home/place of employment of the victim or witness
- Notify victims or witnesses of specific, credible threats received by the Office
