Smithfield Canyon Utility Work

Beginning June 15, 2026, construction activities will begin for the installation of a new Smithfield City waterline in Smithfield Canyon Road. Construction will begin at approximately 1975 Smithfield Canyon Road and extend into the Forest Service Area. Construction is anticipated to last till the end of October 2026. During this time, motorists are encouraged to plan ahead and allow additional travel time. Traffic will be reduced to a single lane through active work zones as construction progresses up the canyon. Those recreating in the Canyon are also advised to use caution when traveling through the construction area. Access through active work zones may be temporarily restricted or delayed, and users should follow all posted signs, barricades, and instructions from construction personnel. Please plan for possible delays and remain alert for construction equipment operating along the roadway. In addition, temporary road closures may be necessary in areas above the residential properties where the roadway is too narrow to safely accommodate both construction activities and traffic. Cache County and Smithfield City will work to notify the public prior to these closures. We appreciate your patience during this infrastructure improvement project.
